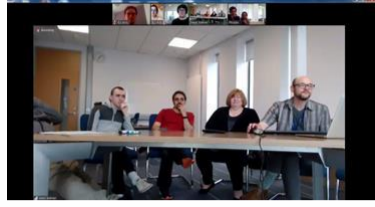


Live Skills included in EUNIC report
